

Dear Members, Affiliates and Individual Members,

Due to the positive development of the COVID epidemic on 16/02/2022, the Federal Council has lifted most restrictions, e.g. no more masks, COVID certificate, etc. are required by law. However, Cantons and individual establishments may still impose such restrictions. In relation to playing Netball, only the following remains in place as requirements by the Federal authorities (and Geneva Canton):

- 1) Those who have tested positive to COVID will need to isolate for at least 5 days, hence they cannot play Netball even if asymptomatic.
- 2) Masks on public transport. Therefore, participants to Netball events should remember to carry and use masks when using public transport.

Moreover, it is recommended that:

- 1) Indoor facilities should be well ventilated.
- 2) People showing any of the following symptoms should stay at home: fever over 38.5, cough or acute respiratory symptoms, muscle aches and/or unexplained tiredness, severe sore throat, severe gastro-intestinal symptoms (nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, etc.), any unexplained skin rashes or similar.
