

Code of Conduct for Swiss Netball Supporters

Swiss Netball welcomes and greatly appreciates the support of the parents, carers, families and friends who travel to netball competitions to support the national team.

Recognising that we all have a responsibility to uphold the highest standards of good sportsmanship in netball, and to positively support the players, management team and delegates, supporters are asked to observe this code of conduct.

We ask that you:

 Respect the squads' time and space throughout the tournament, both on and off the court, at the hotel and playing venues.

The team will travel, train and socialise together. Supporters staying in the same hotel as players should please refrain from diverting the players' attention when they are with their team and/or coaches. Supporters should also please not approach players during training sessions or at any point during a match. Specific time will be built into the programme for players to catch up with family and supporters. Thank you for your understanding.

- Lead by example and show respect for all players, coaches, umpires, administrators and spectators.
- Respect the decision of the coaches, including in match selection.
- Accept the officials' and umpires' decision without comment.
- Use appropriate language at all times.
- Support players to uphold the Code of Conduct for Players.
- Discourage criticism or ridiculing of any player's performance, both during and after the game
- Do not use social media technology to bring the game into disrepute or make an inappropriate comment about a player, coach, official, volunteer or the governing bodies.
- Respect the facilities and equipment.

Please also note that, in line with the Cool & Clean policy adopted by Swiss Netball, smoking is not permitted at training, competition or associated events.
