



Swiss Netball National League Teams & Officials Briefing

1. Welcome everybody to Round 4 of the National League and good luck to all participating teams.
2. Swiss Netball would like to express its gratitude to Zurich Netball Club for hosting Round 4 and thank them for their kind hospitality and support with logistics.
3. Fire exits will be shown to teams and participants upon arrival at the venue.
4. No outdoor shoes or food and drink are allowed in the court areas.
5. Changing facilities will be available.
6. Spectators will be permitted courtside however everyone must be seated on the benches allocated.
7. We ask all members of the Swiss Netball community to abide by the Codes of Conduct, including to show respect for one another when participating in netball-related events.
8. With this in mind, remember umpires are human and may make occasional errors however, please be reminded that [the umpire's decision is final](#).
9. Following the end of the match, please ensure all paperwork is signed accordingly by coaches, umpires and technical officials and returned to the Swiss Netball Operations Lead in attendance.
10. **UMPIRES**
 - Be confident and loud and make sure your hand signals are clear. Be mindful there may be non-English speakers playing in the match
 - If you are approached by a coach or a player regarding something that happened in the match, please make sure you have the support of your co-umpire present with you (or a Swiss Netball committee member/representative)
 - Please be ready on court at the appropriate time.
11. **COACHES**
 - Please ensure your Captains toss for centre pass well before the start of each match and notify the umpires and scorers of first CP and shooting end.
12. Please be reminded that there will be [no exceptions made for jewellery \(ie. no taping of ears will be allowed\)](#).
13. Thank you is extended to the umpires, scorers and timekeepers who are supporting the clubs on this occasion. Please do not distract them while they are performing their duties.
14. Reminder that matches are played to the World Netball 2020 rules regarding substitutions and team changes.
15. Copies of the Swiss Netball Accident/Incident Report form will be provided in case of injury (rule 5.5.2).
