# The 2024 Peppermill Challenge Tournament Information Pack

## 1. Venue

The tournament will be held at Centre sportif du Bois-des-Frères (BdF), Chemin de l'Écu 22, 1219 Châtelaine, Genève.

## 2. Time of Arrival and Registration

- a. Teams should arrive by 09h15 for check in with ID. Matches will start at 10h00. **Players will not be permitted in court areas until the courts are fully marked up.**
- b. **Team registration with all required information must be provided at least 14 days before the event i.e. no later than 2 March 2024** (via the [Team Registration portal](#). See [Team Registration Guidance](#) for completion).
- c. **Any additions to the team registration sheet and/or bench officials** must be logged with the Committee by sending an email to [admin@swiss-netball.ch](mailto:admin@swiss-netball.ch) **no later than 48 hours prior to the start of the event.**

## 3. Tournament Officials

- a. **The Competition Referee, Umpires and Central Timekeeper will be appointed by Swiss Netball.**
- b. **Technical Officials (Scorers):** Clubs must provide a **competent Scorer for each team** entered. The scorers from each team playing must sit together during the match
- c. **Required briefing for coaches, scorers and officials will be held at 09h45.**
- d. Score sheets will be provided by Swiss Netball and **must be handed in to the Competition Referee immediately after the match.**
- e. Please ensure that your **teams are fully conversant in the regulations and fulfil their duties for a smoothly run tournament.**
- f. **The World Netball 2020 rules will apply. All Umpires' decisions are final.**

## 4. Structure of the Tournament

- a. The Peppermill Tournament will take place over 1 day.
- b. Matches will consist of **two 11 minute halves with a 3 minute interval at half time** to accommodate all matches and to maintain central timing.
- c. Placement matches will be played between with teams drawn two positions above and below.
- d. In the event of a tie at the end of extra time in the semi and final matches, a visual signal shall be used to indicate that play shall continue until one team has a two (2) goal advantage.

## 5. Conduct

All teams will be held responsible for the behaviour, demeanour and actions of their players, officials and spectators. Please respect the codes of conduct.

Also note that **any person that is not registered on the team registration list is not permitted at any time to enter the downstairs court area.**

## 6. Players Player Award

Each team will be asked to nominate their Player of the match from the opposing team and they must notify the scorer at the end of each match of her **FULL NAME.**

## 7. First Aid

**All teams will be expected to have their own first aid kit including ice.** Swiss Netball will provide a First Aider for the overall event.

## 8. Accident Report

- a. For ALL injuries and accidents, regardless of whether or not medical treatment is given, an Accident / Incident Report must be completed by the First Aider. For all other incidents, an Accident / Incident Report must be completed by a Swiss Netball Committee member.
- b. Accident report sheets are available from the Competition Referees' table.

**N.B. All participants must carry their own civil liability and medical insurance. Swiss Netball does not accept any liability for accidents and/or injury that may occur.**

## 9. Changing Facilities

Teams will be ascribed a changing facility. Please don't leave valuables in them. Please also respect these areas and leave them tidy.

## **10. Litter**

Please ensure that you keep the courts and surrounding areas tidy by placing your litter in the plastic bags and bins provided and where available use the recycling facilities.

## **11. Lost Property**

Lost property should be taken to the Competition Referees' table.

## **12. Miscellaneous**

- a. We politely request for all teams and players to stay until the end of the competition and remain for the presentation ceremony which will be held at 17h15. This is an act of sportswomanship and respect to all teams in the competition.
- b. Swiss Netball may take team and individual photographs and/or video on the day to use for promotional materials or publicity/marketing purposes etc., in addition to being shared on social media for the purposes of promoting netball in Switzerland. By attending the event, all attendees give their permission to Swiss Netball to take and use photos/videos of attendees as Swiss Netball sees fit.
