Title: Avenir Suisse Assistant Coach, Swiss Netball Programme

Job summary: The Avenir Suisse Assistant Coach works with the Avenir Suisse Coach and with the National Squad Head Coach/Lead Coach to develop plans for the Avenir Suisse Programme; assists the selection of athletes into the Avenir Suisse Programme if applicable and inspires and drives the development of those athletes selected to train in the Avenir Suisse Programme.

The Assistant Coach is motivated and mentored by the Avenir Suisse Coach and a nominated National Squad Coach, if applicable, to help raise the standard of the sport and contribute to the long-term goal of establishing sustainable netball throughout Switzerland.

The Assistant Coach shall be familiar with, and adhere to, all relevant Swiss Netball policies, specifically those regarding eligibility, selection and safeguarding (including codes of conduct). The Coach will respect and maintain the confidentiality of various information and personal data.

Key tasks:

Strategic development

- In coordination with the Swiss Netball Committee Representative and National Squad Head Coach/Lead Coach, support the planning and the effective delivery of an annual programme for the Avenir Suisse Programme, which should fit into an overarching mid-term plan, and also include specific talent development plans and performance plans for Avenir Suisse athletes.
- In line with established Swiss Netball development plans, and in coordination with the Swiss Netball Committee Representative, the Avenir Suisse Coach, the National Squad Head Coach/Lead Coach, and others where appropriate:
- Assist in the Avenir Suisse Annual Programme of training and development in line with the annual programme.
- Assist in talent recognition during training.

Coaching

In line with established Swiss Netball development plans, and in coordination with the Swiss Netball Committee Representative and the National Squad Head Coach/Lead Coach, and others where appropriate:

- Assist in the collation of relevant materials (technical, guidelines, learning, etc.) on

coaching so that Swiss Netball can build resources for local distribution.

Financial responsibilities

- Liaise with the Avenir Suisse Coach regarding any specific resources required.
- Liaise with the Avenir Suisse Coach well in advance of all scheduled training sessions to finalise any necessary logistical arrangements, with the aim of keeping costs to a minimum.

Attendance

The Assistant Coach should attend as many training sessions as possible. These remaining sessions are listed below:

The Swiss Netball Committee maintains overall direction for the Avenir Suisse Programme and as such, the Avenir Coach reports directly to the Avenir Suisse Coach who reports to the Swiss Netball Committee, specifically the Swiss Netball Committee Representative.
