

Swiss Netball Introduction to Umpiring Course

Pre-requisites:

- Must be an individual member of Swiss Netball
- Minimum age: 13 years
- **Cost:** 50.-CHF

This course is strongly recommended as the first step of the umpire development pathway. The course will include theory and practical training on the basics of umpiring including introducing you to the rules, positioning and areas of control and will ensure new umpires understand the basics and continue to build on these skills required to be an effective umpire.

The course will be delivered by Helen Ashton, Swiss Netball Umpire Theory Tutor and will be given in English, however some clarifications can be given in French where needed. Course material of booklet and whistle will be provided.

Perfect for those that want to get to know the basic rules of netball and to start their officiating journey. We hope that you will be motivated and well-informed to take the next step to developing your umpire skills through the Netball Europe C Award Umpire course.
