

Code of Conduct for Club support crews

(Coaches, managers, parents, carers, families and friends of players)

Swiss Netball appreciates and welcomes support from coaches, managers, parents, carers, families, friends and anyone who supports players at Swiss Netball events.

Recognising that we all have a responsibility to uphold the highest standards of good sportsmanship in netball, and to positively support the players, we ask the support crews to observe this code of conduct.

We ask that you:

- Lead by example and show respect for all players, coaches, managers, umpires, tournament officials, volunteers and Swiss Netball Committee members.
- Respect the decision of the coaches, managers, umpires, tournament officials, volunteers and Swiss Netball committee members.
- Accept the officials' and umpires' decision without comment.
- Use appropriate language at all times.
- Support players to uphold the Code of Conduct for Players.
- Discourage criticism or ridiculing of any player, coach, manager, umpire, tournament official, volunteer and Swiss Netball committee member.
- Do not use social media technology to bring the game into disrepute or make an inappropriate comment about a player, coach, manager, umpire, tournament official, volunteer or any Swiss Netball Committee member or the governing bodies.
