

NETBALL EUROPE C AWARD UMPIRE COURSE

The Practical assessments are the required second part of this Umpire Award Course.

Please note only those learner umpires who have attended and passed the Theory course/written exam can then proceed to take the required Practical assessments. Please contact umpiring@swissnetball.ch for more information/scheduling.

PRACTICAL ASSESSMENTS

This will consist of a Pre-assessment and Practical assessment.

C Award Practical Pre-Assessment

- You will have one Assessor and will be assessed on a competitive match for a minimum 2x15 minutes
- The Assessor will grade you on a number of competencies
- If you are assessed to have passed you will be eligible to apply for the C Award Final Practical Assessment
- Your Assessor will provide you with a written report which will highlight all of the positives in your umpiring and also the areas of development
- If you are assessed Not Yet Met Criteria your Assessor will provide you with a written report which will highlight all of the positives in your umpiring and also the areas for development that will allow you to pass the Practical Pre-Assessment in the future.

C Award Final Practical Assessment

- You will have two Assessors and will be assessed on a competitive match for a minimum 2x15 minutes
- The Assessors will grade you on a number of competencies
- Following your Practical Assessment you will attend a post-match debrief with the Assessors. They will tell you the outcome of your assessment and provide you with your areas of strength and the areas for development
- You will either be assessed as a Pass or Not Yet Met Criteria.

Please note if you do not pass the Practical assessments on the day and a re-sit is required, there will be an additional charge of 90.-CHF. In line with the Netball Europe Officiating Pathway, the re-sit of a Practical assessment cannot take place for a minimum period of 3 months from the date of assessment. You must also undertake a further pre-assessment before retaking the Practical assessment.

Cancellation Policy

Due to the restricted budget and operational costs, Swiss Netball operate a no refund policy. If you need to cancel a booking, any request should be made at least 7 days in advance of the course by email to umpiring@swissnetball.ch where you will be offered a priority place on an alternative course. A refund will only be available for illness or injury supported by a medical certificate or under extreme circumstances (these will need to be demonstrated) or if the course is oversubscribed and your place is taken by someone else.

If the course would need to be cancelled for COVID-19 reasons, you will not be charged and you will be reimbursed.
